I have not previously claimed an income tax exemption under this treaty for income received as a teacher, researcher, or student before the date of my arrival in the United States.
4. I will be present in the United States only for such period of time as may be reasonably or customarily required to effectuate the purpose of this visit.
5. I arrived in the United States on _____ (date of last arrival in the U.S. prior to beginning study at The University of Michigan). The treaty exemption is available only for compensation paid during a period of five taxable years, beginning with the taxable year that includes my arrival date.
